

- 999 or 112 can be dialled on the apparatus after accessing the CO line for the purpose of making outgoing calls to the BT emergency service.
- During dialling, this apparatus may tinkle the bells of other telephones using the same line. This is not a fault and we advise you not to call Fault Repair Service.
- If the apparatus does not operate properly, disconnect the unit from the extension line cord and then connect again.
- Power failure transfer

Even if the KX-T7020E is connected to telephone line, it will not operate during a power failure.

## **Initial Setting**




MAX: The volume will be loud. MIN: The volume will be soft.

## **Location of Controls**



KX-T7020E is designed especially for the visually handicapped operators:
 TRANSFER button, SP-PHONE button, and dial key "5" of KX-T7020E have a raised pip to aid them to locate the buttons and keys.

## ① INTERCOM Button and Indicator:

Used to make or receive an intercom call.

## ② CONFERENCE Button and Indicator:

Used to perform a three-party conference.

### ③ REDIAL Button:

Used to redial the last dialled number.

## 4 RECALL Button:

Used to send a recall signal to a Central Office.

## ⑤ Programmable Feature Buttons:

Can be used as One-Touch Dialling buttons or system feature buttons.

## 6 Flexible CO Buttons and Indicators:

Can be used as CO, Direct Station Selection or One-Touch Dialling buttons.

## Tlexible MESSAGE Button and Indicator:

Can be used as Message Waiting, Direct Station Selection or a One-Touch Dialling button.

## TWD/DND Button and Indicator:

Used to set or cancel the Call Forwarding or Do Not Disturb feature.

## **9 TRANSFER Button:**

Used to transfer an outside or intercomicall to another extension.

## 10 PAUSE Button:

Used to insert a pause in a speed dial number.

## ① AUTO DIAL/STORE Button and Indicator:

Used before dialling a speed dial number. / In "PROGRAM" mode, used to store a station programming procedure in the memory at the end of operation.

## **② AUTO ANSWER/MUTE Button** and Indicator:

Used to answer an intercom call automatically. / Used to hear the other party without them hearing you in handsfree mode.

## SP-PHONE Button and Indicator:

Used to make or receive a phone call without using the handset.

## (4) HOLD Button:

Used to place a call on hold.

These Operating Instructions describe basic features and operations of the KX-T7020E used with a Panasonic Electronic Modular Switching System: KX-T30810BE, KX-T61610BE or KX-T123210BE.

## **Feature Descriptions**

#### ■ Automatic Line Access

Allows you to select an unoccupied outside line automatically to make an outgoing call.

## ■ Call Forwarding (FWD)

Calls to your telephone set are automatically forwarded to another preset extension or outside party. The following types are available:

#### - FWD - All Calls

All calls are forwarded to another extension.

#### FWD — Busy or No Answer

Calls are forwarded to another extension when you are busy or do not answer.

#### Conference

Allows you to make a three-inside-party conference.

## ■ Dial Call Pickup

Allows you to answer a call to any extension in your pickup group.

## ■ Directed Call Pickup

Allows you to answer a call from any extension.

## ■ Do Not Disturb

Your telephone set will not receive incoming calls.

#### ■ Flexible CO Button

Can be used as CO button with CO number different from the default or as DSS or One-Touch Dialling button.

#### **■ Flexible MESSAGE Button**

Can be used as Message Waiting, DSS or One-Touch Dialling button

### ■ Individual Line Access

Allows you to select an outside line directly to make an outgoing call.

#### ■ Last Number Redial

Redials the last dialled number.

## **■** One-Touch Dialling

Allows you to dial a stored phone number by pressing one button.

## ■ Paging

There are four paging types as follows:

- All Extensions
  - Group
  - External
  - All Extensions and External

## Paging and Transfer

Allows you to transfer a call to a paged person.

## Paging Answer

Allows you to answer a page.

## **■** System Speed Dialling

Allows you to dial a stored phone number quickly






## Installing the Card Holder

Match the marks ( ▶ ) on the card holder and on the slide rails on the unit.






2 Push two shaded portions slightly and insert the edges of the holder under the slide rails and then slide down in direction of arrow "A."




## Removing the card holder

Push the card holder in the direction of arrow "B" while keeping the tip of the holder pulled in the direction of arrow "C," to take off the holder.




## **Wall Mounting**


1 Turn around the handset hook.




2 Remove the attaching stand.




3 Rotate the stand in the direction of the arrow.




4 Place the stand.

To temporarily place the handset down during a conversation, hook as shown.



## **Others**

If there is any trouble, disconnect the unit from the extension line and connect a known working phone. If the known working phone operates properly, do not reconnect the unit to the extension line until the trouble has been repaired. If the known working telephone does not operate properly, check the Electronic Modular Switching System.

Keep the unit away from heating appliances and electrical noise generating devices such as fluorescent lamps and motors.



The unit should be kept free of dust, moisture and vibration, and should not be exposed to direct sunlight.



Do not use benzine, thinner, or the like, or any abrasive power to clean the cabinet. Wipe it with a soft cloth.



 This unit is capable of being used in conjunction with hearing aids fitted with inductive coil pick-ups.
 The handset should be held as for normal conversation. For operation the hearing aid should be set to it's "T" position or as directed in the operating instructions for the hearing aid.



 KX-T7020E is designed to aid the visually handicapped to locate dial keys and buttons.
